Luang Chakrapani Srisilavisuddhi



It is with sincere regret that we have to record the passing of our colleague, Luang Chakrapani Srisilavisuddhi, member for several years of our Council who at one time carried out the onerous duties of our Hon. Secretary. Of a family of lawyers, the late Luang Chakrapani, born as Visuddh Krairiksh, was sent to be educated in England. He entered Queen's College, Oxford, made himself a valuable member of that institution, and eventually was graduated in the Final Honour School of Jurisprudence. He combined his studies at the University with those in the legal field at the Middle Temple, London, and he was also called to the English Bar. Returning to his motherland, he adopted the legal profession, rising rapidly in it till he became a prominent member of the Dika Court of Final Appeal. Luang Chakrapani took care not to neglect the social and non-professional sides of his life. In his cultural and executive activities on behalf of the Siam Society, of which he indeed deserved to be regarded as an ideal member, he was always attentive and most punctilious in whatever duty was required of him.
