The Annual General Meeting terminating the year 1957 was held at the Society's Home, 60 Asoka Road, Bangkapi on Monday, 10th March 1958, with H.H. Prince Prem Purachatra, Senior Vice-President, in the chair, the President being away in attendance upon their Majesties on their tour of the north.

The Meeting unanimously re-elected H.H. Prince Dhani Nivat, Kromamun Bidyalabh, as President of the Siam Society for 1958, and the old Council was re-elected en bloc with the addition of Mr. W. Wheaton who was acting for the Honorary Editor of the Journal while the latter was absent on home leave.

Mr. Cecil L. Sanford was unanimously re-elected by the Council as Honorary Editor of the Journal.

In May 1958 our Honorary Treasurer, Mr. Jorgen Holm, had to leave for Denmark on account of illness and he was temporarily replaced by Mr. U. Underland of the Royal Norwegian Legation, who managed the Society's accounts in a very competent manner. The Society was fortunate enough to have the service of Mr. Jorgen Holm again when he, fully recovering from his ailment, returned to Bangkok in November of the same year.

It was a pleasure to the Council to see the return of Mr. J.J. Boeles, our Corresponding Member, to this country in the middle of the year. Because Mr. Boeles, who had previously been an active Council member, continued to take a keen interest in the Society's activities, he was co-opted as member of the Council in August 1958.

The Council held eleven business meetings during the year under review. Ten meetings took place in the President's house in Pechaburi Road and one meeting in the Society's Home in Bangkapi.

as compared with the number 618 in 1957. It is a source of gratification to the Council to see the increase in ordinary membership from year to year.

Deaths, however, dealt a heavy blow to the Society. The untimely death of our former Honorary Secretary, Mr. Robin Penman, occurred on 19th June 1958, and two of our Honorary Members passed away, namely: Major Erik Seidenfaden and Sir Walter Williamson. Luang Chakrapani, a former Honorary Secretary and several times member of the Council, also died. The Society mourns their loss greatly.

The Honorary Secretaryship of the Society has been taken over by H.S.H. Prince Ajavadis Diskul, who was Mr. Robin Penman's predecessor in this post, and who now retains at the same time his post of a Vice-President.

The financial standing of the Society can definitely be said to be satisfactory. At the close of the year under review the excess of receipts over expenditure amounted to Baht 49,277.19, a figure unsurpassed in the history of the Siam Society. This is derived from the fact that our effort in increasing the sale of publications has met with some success and several of our ordinary members have chosen to become life members.

On account of the increase in membership and a bigger demand by the general public of our Journal, the Council decided to increase the publication of the Journal from 800 copies to 1,000 copies. In 1958 the Society issued two numbers of the Journal, namely: Volume 46, Part 1 (June 1958) and Volume 46, Part 2 (November 1958). It also published "The Thai Peoples" by the late Major Erik Seidenfaden. It is hoped that in the following year the Society will be able to publish at least another issue of the Natural History Bulletin as well as further numbers of the Journal.

In June 1958, the Society was requested by and gave its permission to the Thai Embassy in Copenhagen to publish extracts from the Journal, Volume 31, Part 1 (March 1939), giving accounts of the Early Trade Relations between Thailand and Denmark on the occasion of the celebration of the Centenary of Treaty Relationship between the two countries.

Some of our senior officers travelled abroad during the year: our late Honorary Secretary made an extensive tour in America and England speaking on the subject of the Siam Society at various centers and making contacts on behalf of the Society. Recently also our President, H.H. Prince Dhani Nivat, Kromamun Bidyalabh, at the invitation of the Vietnam Association to study Asian Cultural Relations, visited the University of Saigon in December 1958 and lectured on the subject of the Siam Society.

During the year the Siam Society was invited to send representatives to some of the international gatherings in the cause of science, such as the International Congress of History at Lisbon in August 1958, etc., but the exigencies of time and distance prevented our attendance.

It is a great honour to the Society that Their Majesties graced one of our Ordinary General Meetings in July 1958, when the royal films were shown to our members and their guests after a lecture on "The North Revisited" by our President.
