## ANTLERS OF THE MALAYAN SAMBAR

During a visit of the members of the Thailand Research Society to Nakon Pathom I noticed a large pair of antlers of the *Malayan Sambar* (*C. unicolor equicolor equinus*) (see illustration) in the eastern Vihara of Phra Pathom. The antlers are especially remarkable owing to their extraordinarily developed brow-tines, each of which has 4 points. I have taken the measurements of the antlers, which are as follows:

Length on outside curve: left: 31;" right:  $29\frac{3}{4}$ "

Circumference at the base

(i. e. below the brow-tines): left: 11; right:  $11\frac{1}{2}$ 

 $Tip \ to \ Tip$  : 18''

Points: : left: 6; right: 6
