

SYMPLOCOS (§ CORDYLOBLASTE) HENSCHELII
NEW FOR THAILAND

Symplocos henschelii (Mor.) Bth. ex Clarke in Hook. f., Fl. Br. Ind. 3 (1882) 568, pro nomen; Steen., Bull. Bot. Gard. Btzg III, 17 (1948) 431, 440, fig. 2. — *Cordyloblaste henschelii* Mor., Bot. Zeit. 6 (1848) 605–606. — *S. sukoei* C.E.C. Fischer, Kew Bull. (1929) 315.

Thailand. Northern Division, Chiengmai, Chawmthawng, Mae Klang, c. 1200 m, Roy. For. Dep. 18156 (K. Suvarnasuddhi 336), May 29, 1939, large tree in hill evergreen forest, flower white; bark smooth, grey, out yellow; wood white, smooth-grained.

This is the second locality of this W. Malaysian tree from continental S.E. Asia, the other record being that by Fischer, from Mergui.
