NOTES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

The bulletin is open to members of the Society and all scientists, who are interested in the study of the natural history of South East Asia.

Manuscripts should be typewritten and double-spaced on one side of ordinary paper (Qto/Flscp.), and submitted to the Hon. Editor. It is advisable that a paper should not exceed 20 typed pages to enable publication in one issue. Longer papers are acceptable under the condition that they will be subjected to serialised publication.

Manuscripts should be submitted in final form, for proofs are not the place for alterations on account of style. It is preferable that two copies including the top-copy should be sent for editorial use.

Latin scientific names and words or sentences to be italicized should be underlined once and boldfaced printing should be underlined twice

Tables and diagrams should be on separate sheets, accompanied by explanatory headings, and numbered with Arabic numerals. Illustrations in colour must be arranged specially, but black and white photographic illustrations are welcomed. Captions should be written on the back or attached. Line drawings should be made with Indian ink on white drawing paper and should indicate scale. Photographs should be printed on glossy paper with sharp contrast.

The author will receive 30 reprints free of charge. Joint authors will have to divide these copies between them. Reprints exceeding this number must be paid for by the author, and must be ordered with the typescript.
