VIII. POMMERESCHEA LACKNERI FOUND IN THAILAND

The genus *Pommereschea* (Zingiberaceae) was described by Witt-MARCK in 1895. The rhizome of the plant was introduced by chance to Germany by Carl Lackner with orchids from Burma. As far as it is known to the author, this is the only collection ever made until we refound it in Thailand in 1958. The species is not represented in Kew nor in Berlin, and the type was probably destroyed in Berlin during the war. During the last few years it has been collected repeatedly by botanists visiting the limestone massif of Doi Chiang Dao north of Chiang Mai in Northern Thailand, not far from the Burmese frontier.

The plant grows here above 2000 metres in open shrub vegetation among big limestone boulders—and it does not seem to be infrequent. We collected several specimens in 1958 during our first visit to the mountain, regarding the collection as belonging to the genus *Globba* to which it shows great resemblance; unfortunately our material was not flowering, but had only young flowerbuds. During a visit to Edinburgh Mr. B.L. Burtt of the herbarium kindly helped me with the determination.




Fig. 2. Pommereschea lackneri Wittmarck

In 1958 I undertook a fixation of root tips from the population on Chieng Dao. Fig. 1 shows the somatic division and the chromosome number 2n = 22, a rather frequently found number in the Zingiberaceae. In fig. 2 SAT-chromosomes are seen indicating the species as diploid.
